

Photographic Workshops at Arkaroola

With acclaimed landscape photographer Peter MacDonald

Peter has had a long association with Arkaroola and has years of experience shooting in this wonderful part of the world.

Join him for a one or two day workshop which will help anyone from beginner to experienced photographer get the most from their digital camera.

Topics will include composition, exposure, work flow, the digital dark room, how to be creative in the field — and a demonstration of Peter's techniques.

His broad knowledge of the flora, fauna, geology and history of the northern Flinders Ranges is an added bonus.

Participants will be able to draw on his photographic knowledge and creative skills to make their own landscape images.

The workshops are available for individuals or groups limited to a maximum of 6, ensuring participants obtain maximum benefit from each of the sessions.

Because Peter shoots exclusively with Canon digital equipment and because of the many makes and models of cameras today, it is advisable to bring along your camera's operating manual. During the workshop you will need to find out how your camera achieves some of the techniques that will be discussed. A tripod would be an almost essential accessory.

Workshops can be arranged, depending on Peter's availability, by appointment through Reception at Arkaroola - telephone (08) 8648 4848.

Peter charges a flat fee of \$900 per day per group.

The workshops will be fairly intense, starting prior to dawn and including a late afternoon session. Participants will visit several locations throughout the day.

A display of some of Peter's Arkaroola images can be seen in the Arkaroola restaurant. Two of his 6 metre long panoramas from the Ridgetop area are also on display in the Greenwood complex.

He also produces a website www.thesentimentalbloke.com where four or five times a week photographs of his work covering a wide range of topics and locations will be posted. Usually each photograph is accompanied by some photographic information or details about the subject in the image.

The 'Sentimental Bloke' has a large following here in Australia and in about 45 countries worldwide.
